Kindling the spirit of patriotism among the children, the Interact club organised an activity of **Colouring the National Flag** for the students of Shiksha Kendra on 25th July, 2018. Children belonging to grade I to III participated in this activity. The Interactors contributed white ivory sheets and boxes of colour pencils for the same. The outline of the tri-colour was printed on the ivory sheets which were later cut out and distributed among the students of the above mentioned grades. The boxes of colour pencils were shared by children during the activity.
