Class II - Visit to Ahinsa Sthal

An educational trip to Ahinsa Sthal built in mid 80's was organized in the last week of January to inculcate the values of peace, harmony and non-violence among the students. Situated on Mehrauli road, Ahinsa Sthal is an epitome of eternal peace and much needed non-violence and named after the founder of Jain Dharma, Mahavir Jain whose 14 feet tall statue is the centre of attraction.
