

Report – Educational trip to Jim Corbett

To promote learning through outdoor interactions and experiences, Delhi Public School, Gurgaon, organized a three day fun-filled, educational tour to Corbett National Park for the students of classes IV and V from 2nd May'19 to 4th May '19. The tour commenced with a briefing by a naturalist on the rich biodiversity of the area.
