

Report - Science Day (Junior School)

To develop the scientific thinking, creativity and problem-solving skills amongst the students, Delhi Public School, Gurgaon, celebrated Science Day in the Junior Wing on 2nd and 3rd August, 2019.

The day commenced with a video presentation to emphasise upon the fact that potable water today is depleting at a very high rate and to conserve it is the most important need of the hour. This was followed by an interactive session with the students who shared their innovative ideas to save water.
