

REPORT- Transforming Library for Digital Natives

The webinar on ‘Transforming Library for Digital Natives’ was conducted by the International Council of School Leadership, on 26th March 2021. It was attended by the teachers of the Library Department, Delhi Public School, Gurgaon.

The session was hosted by Mr Atul Nishchal, Founder and Director, ICSL and the panel comprised of Mr. Ashok Pandey, Director, Ahlcon Group of Schools and Mr. G. Balasubramanian, Board of Advisors, ICSL. The panelists shared their thoughts on the future of library in the digital world.

The highlights of the webinar:

Library for students and by students – A library should be curated with the help of students and teachers together, so that it adds a larger value to a student’s life.

Book Review – Students should have a platform to share their reviews after reading a book, so that it can be recommended to their peers.

Utilization of Resources – Teachers should guide students in efficiently utilizing the resources available in the library.

Motivation to Read– Teachers and parents should come together for a book discussion in the library at least once a week with the students. They can recommend a book of their interest and also help them explore various genres of books.

A number of librarians from different parts of India participated in this webinar. It was an enriching experience for all the participants.
