A conference with the theme 'Students- at-Risk - Identification, Prevention and Intervention' was organized for the leaders of various educational institutes with the purpose to understand the various risk factors that the students are susceptible to in the school. The conference began with an enriching talk by Dr. V. S. Ravindran who spoke about the social, academic and psychological needs of students 'At-Risk'. He also visited the current dimensions and future trends of the schools and threw light on the changing role of the school Principals.
