

Report – Training Programme- Application of ICT in School Libraries

The Human Resource Development Centre, DPS Society organized a three day workshop from Monday 19th August 2019 to 21st August 2019 for librarians across the country, to enhance the ICT learning skills and manage libraries in the digital era. The workshop was inaugurated by Mr Pramod Grover, Prof B.P Khandelwal and Ms Vinita Kher at DPS Mathura Road, New Delhi.
