

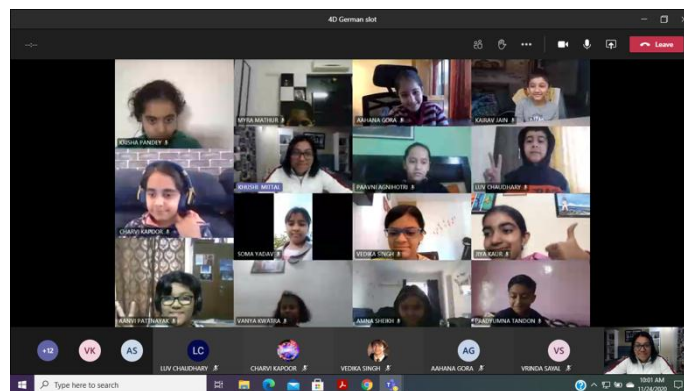
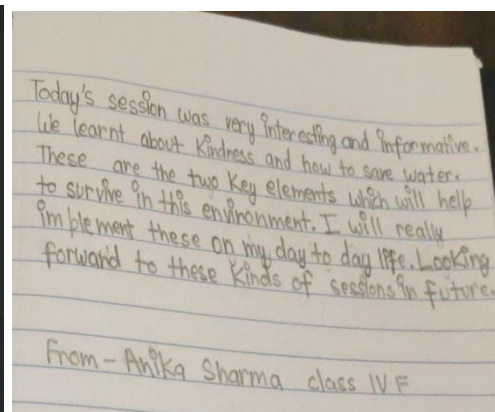
“You can always be the rainbow in someone’s cloudy sky.”
