REPORT- CYBER SAFETY AND DIGITAL CITIZENSHIP

The Cyber Congress of the school, comprising of grade 12 students, visited the online classes of grade 6, 7 and 8, from 22nd to 30th September 2020.

They made a presentation on Cyber Safety and Digital Citizenship, which made the students aware of the importance of being digitally safe i.e. learning how to safeguard themselves and others when connecting through digital devices, the Dos and Don'ts of the cyber world and the need for digital citizenship, especially in a world which is increasingly dependent on the internet. Students were reminded of all the actions to be taken to remain vigilant in this new digital age to ensure online safety, digital responsibility, digital health and wellness, and prevention of any form of cyber bullying. The following key points were discussed during the session:

- 1. Keeping strong passwords and not sharing personal information with strangers.
- 2. Not make any fake accounts or share personal pictures.
- 3. Always check the source of the information before clicking on any link.
- 4. To never share one-time passwords or financial information or passwords with anyone.
- 5. To never respond to strangers on phone or text.
- 6. To have a good anti- virus software and firewall installed in the computer.
- 7. To be an ethical digital citizen i.e. one who represents responsible digital behavior.
