

Workshop on ‘Solar Lamp Assembly’

DPS Gurgaon became part of the Guinness World Record Event by conducting ‘The Student Solar Ambassador Workshop’, an initiative of IIT Bombay and Ministry of New and Renewable Sources of Energy, on Wednesday, 2nd October’19. This was a mega-global event, wherein more than 1 million students from over 180 countries got hands-on training to assemble their own solar study lamp in 10,000 different locations.

The objective of this workshop was to sensitize the young generation towards climate change and its repercussions. It also motivated them to participate in climate mitigation efforts as Student Solar Ambassadors and promote use of Solar Energy.

For the workshop, solar lamp assembly kits were procured before hand and three teachers became Master Trainers by taking online training of Solar Lamp Assembly, provided by IIT Bombay.

Since 2nd October, the birth anniversary of Mahatma Gandhi, is also celebrated as the International Day of Non-Violence, all Student Solar Ambassadors along with the students of *Shiksha Kendra* took the pledge of non-violence towards the environment, in the presence of Director Principal, Ms. Aditi Misra and Dean Student Welfare, Ms. Sapna Dhawan.

The entire programme was well conceptualised and the objectives were achieved by the school. Students as well as teachers had an enriching hands-on experience and were motivated to respect our natural resources.
