



WORLD SCHOLAR'S CUP GLOBAL ROUND – BANGKOK

Delhi Public School, Sector 45, Gurgaon proudly represented India at the World Scholar's Cup Global Round held in Bangkok from 27th June to 3rd July 2025. A delegation of fifteen students—six in the Senior Division and nine in the Junior Division engaged in a week-long celebration of knowledge, collaboration and international camaraderie. The event brought together over 500 scholars from 34 countries.
