World Scholar's Cup Regional Round 2025

Students of Delhi Public School, Sector 45, Gurgaon participated with distinction in the World Scholar's Cup (WSC) Regional Round 2025, held at Pathways School, Gurgaon from 12th to 15th April 2025. This academic event brought together nearly 1400 young scholars from both Junior and Senior categories, across the region to engage in a celebration of learning and global discourse.

The theme for WSC 2025 'Reigniting the Future' enabled participants to showcase their skills in five intellectually enriching events - Team Debate, Scholar's Bowl, Collaborative Writing, Scholar's Challenge and Talent Showcase, each designed to foster critical thinking, creativity and communication.

The Junior Division, comprising 18 students, secured an impressive 40 Gold Medals, 27 Silver Medals and 2 Trophies, with one team achieving 5th Rank Overall and 5th in Debate Champions among nearly 900 students.

The Senior Division, consisting of 27 students, earned 35 Gold Medals and 43 Silver Medals, with several participants recognised as Debate Champions. A special mention goes to Vikramaditya Sen (Class X), who was declared Rank 1 – Top Debater in Gurgaon and was also selected for the prestigious Debate Showcase, competing among almost 500 students.

All participating teams from both Junior and Senior Divisions qualified for the Global Round. This outstanding performance reflects our students' intellectual curiosity and perseverance.
